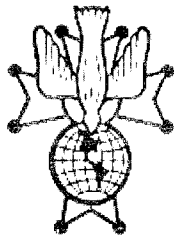


Tickets for the luncheon should be picked up on Friday evening in the Masters Hospitality Room number 2014. Please pass this information on.
